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




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

Admiral 3 is on the North side of Rannalhi on the outside reef in the channel. It is a wall that starts at 7 meters, and the drop-off continues down to 28 meters. There is a good chance to see big fish in the channel entry.

With a bit of luck we can spot nurse sharks in the bomie of the south-east lagoon, or at the east cave. White-tip reef sharks and stingrays are found on the sandy bottom, and eagle rays cruise by.

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




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

Appa Thila is a large reef on the inside of the atoll. West side of the reef is a beautiful terrace with lots of soft corals. In 60 minutes it is possible to swim around half of the site. Small overhangs can be seen on the east side. A great dive site for photographers.

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

Your best dive at Cocoa Corner will be when the northeast incoming ocean current hits this atoll, which then only requires you a minimal fin kick to cruise along. This can be a long drift or a short drift dive. Make sure you do not miss the corner.

White tip and grey reef sharks, hawksbill and huge green turtles, tunas and which luck a surprise appearance of thresher sharks, leatherback turtles, marlins and hammerheads.

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




Dongmas Giri is a small round reef in the middle of the atoll. A drop off from 1-12 meters on the south side is where there are small bomies covered with compact coral that shelter loads of glass fish. The west side has some beautiful overhangs. Diving with a torch is highly recommended.

Frequently seen: Turtles, Octopus, Nudibranchs, Big Groupers, Pipe fish on the south side, Black corals, and schools of yellow back fusilier.

The sides of the "thila" are covered with soft corals. The currents are strong here so this site is highly recommended for Advanced and Nitrox divers.

There are many species to encounter including schools of eagle rays, white tip sharks, barracudas, green turtles, and grey reef sharks. Tiger sharks are a guest appearance.

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

This is often said to be one of the best dive sites in the Maldives, and one of the best shark dive sites in the world. This is a pinnacle dive that is relatively small and shaped like a teardrop. There is a channel that runs between this pinnacle and the reef and normally brings with it large amounts of current. However, this is where most of the action on this dive is. The dive site has a minimum depth of around 13 meters that drops down to around 40 meters. It is covered with many large table corals, coral blocks, and stag horns. The coral blocks are cleaning stations for reef fish and draw in a vast number of marine life that divers can expect to see here. At the western point of the pinnacle is an area that is called Jack Corner for the large amounts of big-eyed jacks in the area. They are not alone, however, and are joined by large groups of
